

Du'a when the New Year begins

Sayyiduna 'Abdullah ibn Hisham رضي الله عنه reports that the Sahabah رضي الله عنهم would learn the following du'a for when **the new month or New Year would begin**:

اللَّهُمَّ ادْخِلْهُ عَلَيْنَا بِالْأَمْنِ وَالْإِيمَانِ، وَالسَّلَامَةِ وَالْإِسْلَامِ، وَجِوَارٍ مِّنَ الشَّيْطَانِ، وَرِضْوَانٍ مِّنَ الرَّحْمَنِ.

Allahumma adkhilhu 'alayna bil amni wal iman, was salamati wal islam, wa jiwarim minash shaytan, wa ridwanim minar Rahman.

Translation: O Allah, bring this [month or year] upon us with security, iman, safety, Islam, protection from Shaytan, and Your pleasure.

(Mu'jamus Sahabah of Baghawi, and Al-Mu'jamul Awsat of Tabarani, Hadith: 6237)

'Allamah Haythami رحمته الله has ruled the chain of Tabarani as sound (*hasan*). Hafiz Ibn Hajar رحمته الله has graded the chain that was quoted by 'Allamah Baghawi for this narration as authentic (*sahih*).
